As we reflect on the remarkable journey of the 2023-24 school year, we are thrilled to share with you this year's Annual Report. Anchored by our theme, "The Creed In-Deed," this year encouraged our entire community to live out Hamlin's guiding principles of courage, compassion, honesty, responsibility, and respect. These values illuminated every aspect of our shared experience, bringing us together in profound ways.

Gifts to Hamlin Year Ended - June 30, 2024

ANNUAL FUND — \$2,353,000

These Annual Fund dollars provide an essential contribution to the operating budget and help close the gap between the cost of tuition and the actual cost of a Hamlin education.

PARENTS ASSOCIATION CONTRIBUTION — \$400,000

Proceeds from Hamlin Parents Association events and activities (such as the Fall Fundraiser, Winterfest, the Spring Fundraiser, the School Store, and eScrip) are donated to the operating budget each year. This donation supports the budgets for faculty professional development opportunities and the student financial assistance program.

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS — \$739,524

Gifts and pledges to the Love, Hamlin campaign support the endowment, increased faculty/staff compensation, and building transformation.

Endowment & Similar Funds Year Ended - June 30, 2024

Endowment and similar funds represent predictable sources of revenues to the School. These funds help to ensure the continuity of School programs and provide a foundation on which future programs can be developed and implemented.

Funds give the School administration and trustees the flexibility and confidence to grow, improve, and respond to strategic developments.

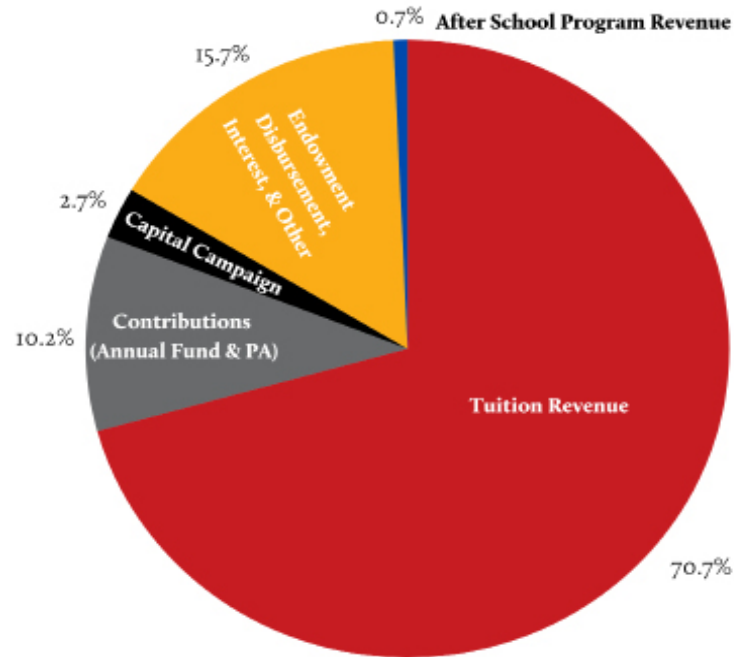
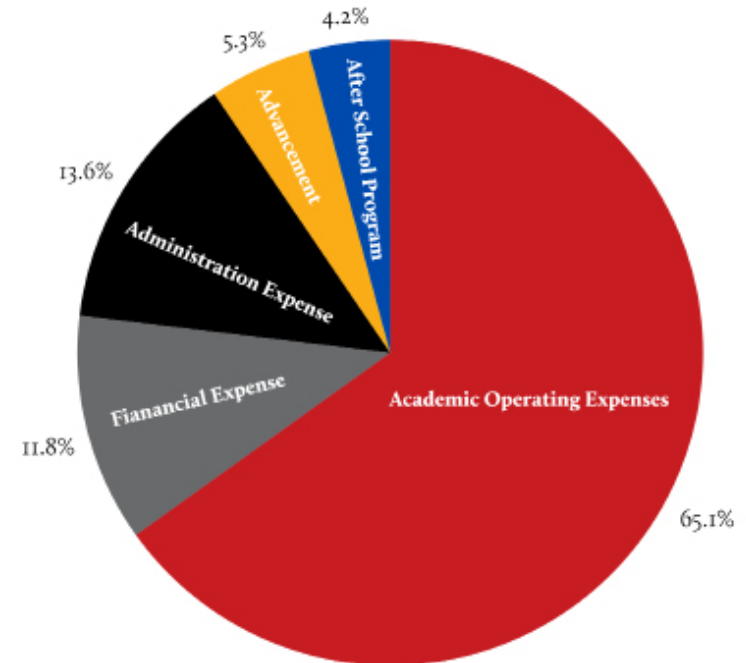


EXHIBIT II. 2023-24 SCHOOL EXPENDITURES
